REPRESENTATIVE TO THE CONTRA COSTA COUNTY AVIATION ADVISORY COMMITTEE

Purpose and Objectives

The purpose of the Aviation Advisory Committee is to provide advice and recommendations to the Board of Supervisors on the general subject of aviation issues related to the airports in Contra Costa County.

The Aviation Advisory Committee may initiate discussions, observations, or investigations, in order to make recommendations on aviation or airport matters to the Board of Supervisors.

The Aviation Advisory Committee may hear comments on airport and aviation matters from the public or other agencies for consideration and possible recommendations to the Board of Supervisors or their designates.

The Aviation Advisory Committee shall cooperate with local, state, and national aviation interests for the safe and orderly operation of aircraft.

The Aviation Advisory Committee shall advance and promote the interests of aviation and protect the general welfare of the people living and working near the airport and the County in general.

In conjunction with all of the above, the Aviation Advisory Committee shall provide a forum for the Manager of Airports regarding operational and/or policy matters at and around the airport.

Meeting Times and Places

Meetings will be held on the third Tuesday of each month beginning at 7:30 p.m. at the Buchanan Field Airport. The adjournment will be no later than 10:00 p.m., unless otherwise ordered by the Chairman of the Aviation Advisory Committee.

Number of Members and Length of Office

Twelve members, each serve two-year terms.

Membership Requirements

The Contra Costa County Aviation Advisory Committee is comprised of twelve members. Appointments to the committee are made by the Board of Supervisors. All members must be County residents: one is recommended by one of the five (5) County Supervisors; one from and recommended by the City of Concord, and one from and recommended by the City of Pleasant Hill; one from and recommended by Diablo Valley College; one from and recommended by the Fixed Base Operators Association; one from and recommended by the Airport Land Use Commission; one member is at-large to represent property owners and tenants living in the near vicinity of the Buchanan Field Airport, and is appointed by the Board of Supervisors; and one member is at-large to represent interests of the Byron Community. (This member must be a resident of the East County with the East County being defined as including Pittsburg and all areas east. All interested parties will be interviewed by the CCC Aviation Advisory Committee and is ranked for and then appointed by the Board of Supervisors.)
