### **Concord to hold its first by district election on November 6, 2018 - Candidates for City Council seats in Districts 1, 3, and 5 and City Treasurer can pick up papers July 16**

Concord, CA (July 5, 2018) – Nomination papers for seats on the Concord City Council in Districts 1, 3, and 5 and City Treasurer will be available beginning on Monday, July 16, 2018, from the City Clerk's office at Civic Center, 1950 Parkside Drive. Candidates should make an appointment with City Clerk Joelle Fockler prior to picking up papers to review the filing process. Please call Joelle at (925) 671-3390 schedule an appointment.

A nominee must be a registered voter in the open District (a registered voter in the City of Concord for City Treasurer). The General Municipal Election will be held on Tuesday, Nov. 6, 2018. This will be the first by [district election](#) in Concord.

Nomination papers must be filed with the City Clerk in person not later than 5 p.m. on August 10. If the City Treasurer incumbent does not file, the filing deadline for non-incumbents for City Treasurer will be extended to Wednesday, Aug. 15.
