The City of Concord in cooperation with other Central County cities, funds the Household Hazardous Waste Collection Facility. This facility accepts HHW from residents for recycling. There is no charge to use this service and no appointment is necessary for Concord residents.

Drop-off Hours For Residents:

Tuesday–Saturday, 9 a.m.–4 p.m.
The facility is closed on holidays.

Businesses:

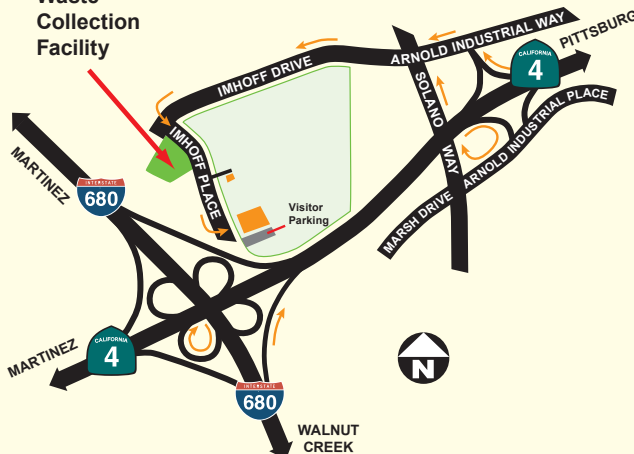

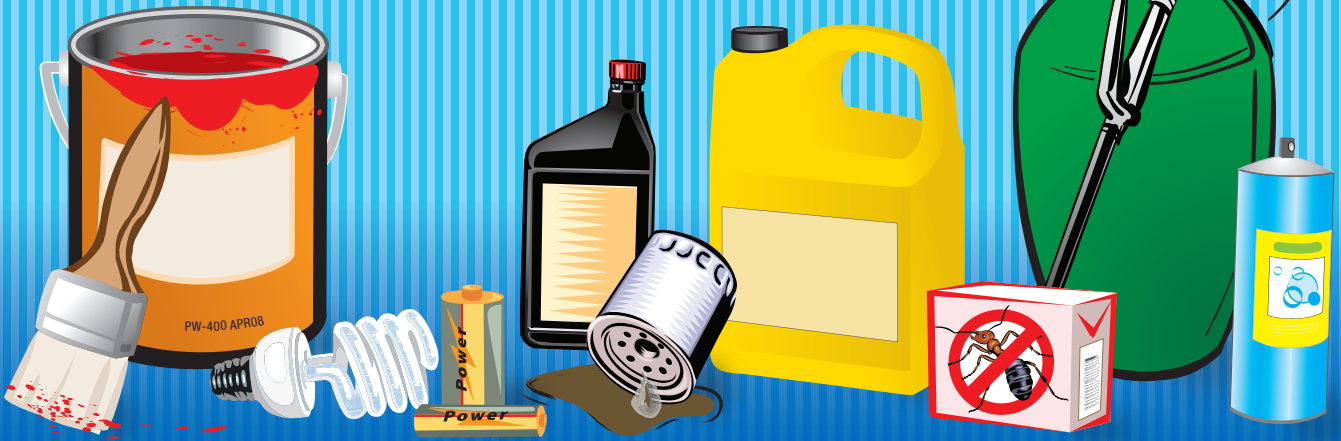

 Recycling hazardous waste is a good way to reduce water pollution. The City of Concord also partners with 18 other cities to provide public education, industrial outreach, water quality monitoring, construction inspection, street sweeping, storm drain cleaning, storm drain stenciling, fleet maintenance, illicit discharge response, creek maintenance, and Integrated Pest Management.

What HHW is **NOT** Accepted

- **Medical waste, Sharps** (needles, scalpels, etc.) and **Medications**
- **Waste contaminated with PCBs at more than 50 ppm** (fluorescent light ballasts containing PCBs are accepted)
- **Radioactive material** – County Health Department (925) 646-5225
- **Explosive waste** (including ammunition, picric acid, and fireworks) – contact local law enforcement agency (925) 671-3220
- **Unlabeled or unknown compressed gas cylinders** (propane accepted) – contact local gas suppliers
- **E-waste** – for information on e-waste disposal see the California Integrated Waste Management Board's website www.ciwmb.ca.gov
- **Treated Wood Waste**
