Tour Itinerary

Oct. 18: Bay Area/Kyoto

Board your flight to Japan. Depart San Francisco on your flight to Osaka Kansai – the closest airport to Kyoto. We lose one day as we cross the Int'l Dateline.

Oct. 19: Arrive Osaka/Kyoto

Arrive in Osaka Kansai Airport and be met by your guide. A private Motorcoach will transport you to your hotel in Kyoto - journey time will be 2 hours. You will arrive to your hotel in the late evening.

Accommodation: (3 Nights) Hotel Okura

Oct. 20: Kyoto (B,L)

Full day tour of Kyoto by private Motorcoach to visit Kinkakuji Temple (Golden Pavilion), Ryoanji Temple famous for its Zen rock gardens, followed by a special lunch in the mountains of Kibune. After lunch visit Kibune Shrine and finally Fushimi Inari Taisha Shrine with its many red torii gates.

Oct. 21: Kyoto (B)

Full day tour of Kyoto by private Motorcoach to visit the Heian Shrine, Nijo Castle with its famous "nightingale floors", the Shin Kyogoku covered shopping arcade, the Nishiki Market and the Gion Geisha District.

Oct. 22: Kyoto/Takayama (B,D)

This morning we depart for Takayama, a calm and charming city nicknamed "little Kyoto" by private motorcoach. As with Kyoto, scenic mountains surround the city, and the streets are built in cross bar pattern. Takayama is famous for "Shunkei-nuri" (lacquer ware) and other woodcraft. A walk down the streets is a stroll down memory lane – reminiscent of 18th century Japan. Our Takayama sightseeing tour today includes a visit to Yatai Kaikan, the storehouse for the floats used in the annual festival parade; and Sanmachi-suji, a street of old homes and shops. Tonight, we enjoy at a Japanese style dinner.

Accommodation: (1 Night) Hotel Associa Resort

Oct. 23: Takayama/Shirakawago/Kanazawa (B)

Early this morning, visit the Morning Market, Asaichi, where farmers from the neighboring areas bring their fresh produce, tsukemono, local souvenirs, etc., to sell to local residents and tourists. Then we drive on to enjoy a special visit to the UNESCO Site, Shirakawago (Ogimachi Gassho Village, a lovely park with reconstructed farm houses in the Gassho Zukuri style). We continue our drive to Kanazawa, which was the home of the wealthy Maeda Family (Edo Period), who built their castle and gardens here, and ruled with a flair for grandeur. Kanazawa is a labyrinth of narrow, winding streets and blind alleys; rows of ancient samurai homes surrounded by earthen walls; and workshops that carry on traditional arts and crafts. Since ancient times, this city has been known for its Kaga-Yuzen (colorfully dyed silks), Kutani pottery and lacquer ware. It is also the headquarters for various schools of Noh, tea ceremony and flower arrangement.

For your stay in Kanazawa please use a small shoulder bag or backpack as we will send your main luggage by courier from Takayama to Kitakami this morning.

Accommodation: (1 Night) Kanazawa Tokyu Hotel

Oct. 24: Kanazawa/Kitakami (B)

Our morning tour of Kanazawa includes a visit to Kenrokuen Garden, designated one of the three most beautiful gardens in all Japan; Seison-kaku Villa; and the Nagamachi district of ancient samurai homes (buke-yashiki). We next head for your sister city home stay of Kitakami by Shinkansen Bullet Trains. By late this afternoon you will be meeting with your homestay families and saying sayonara to your guide.

Oct. 25, 26, 27: Kitakami (Meals Host Family)

Enjoy your stay with your host families, various Sister City activities and tours of Kitakami.

Oct. 28: Kitakami/Tokyo (Meals Host Family)

Today a fond farewell to your host families and sister city of Kitakami and travel by Shinkansen Bullet Train to Tokyo. Your guide will meet you at Tokyo Station and transfer you to your hotel by private Motorcoach.

Please use a small shoulder bag or backpack as we will send your main luggage by courier from Kitakami to Tokyo this morning and your luggage will arrive the next day.

Accommodation: (2 Night) Shibuya Excel Hotel Tokyu

Oct. 29: Tokyo (B,L)

Today your full day sightseeing by private Motorcoach will include a visit to Meiji Jingu Shrine and then out to Odaiba area to ride the Giant famous ferries wheel for excellent views of Tokyo Bay and the Rainbow Bridge. Cross the Rainbow Bride to arrive at Biancane for a special farewell lunch. In the afternoon visit Asakusa Sensoji Temple and its Nakamise Shopping Arcade selling many traditional souvenirs and sweets. Then visit one of Tokyo's newest attractions Sky Tree and go up to its observation deck.

Oct. 30: Tokyo/Bay Area (B)

This morning you will have free time to explore Shibuya district one last time before boarding your private Motorcoach to the airport. We must say "Sayonara" to lovely Japan and our new friends, and fly back to USA.
