



PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of Concord will conduct a public hearing per Elections Code Section 21607.1 during its regular City Council meeting on April 5, 2022, at 7:00 p.m., at which time the City Council will 1) receive a report from staff on the redistricting process and permissible criteria to be considered to redraw City Council election district boundaries; 2) conduct a public hearing with a focus on draft map(s) including those submitted by the public, to receive and consider public input on the draft map(s), communities of interest, and potential district boundaries, provide direction on draft map option(s) and refinement(s); 3) adopt Ordinance No. 22-3 amending Concord Municipal Code Chapter 2.35 (Elections) to permit the district boundaries for “by districts” elections to be established by resolution; and 4) adopt a resolution establishing district boundaries for “by district” elections. Every 10 years, following each federal census, California cities that used district-based election systems must review the boundaries of these voting districts and re-adopt boundaries based on current census data. The purpose of this redistricting process is to ensure that voting districts remain substantially equal in population and still protect the rights of members of communities of interests to vote for the candidates of their choice.

NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that the City Council of the City of Concord will hold a **PUBLIC HEARING** on this matter in the Council Chamber, located at 1950 Parkside Drive, on Tuesday, April 5, 2022, at 7:00 p.m. (or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard) at which time and place interested persons may appear and be heard.

CEQA: Not a project per CEQA Guidelines Sections 15320, 15378 and 15061(b)(3) as it is an organizational structure change and does not have the potential to result in either a direct or reasonable foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment.
